Any person who wishes a public hearing on the possible alternative locations for the project of their effects should make a written request on or before July 27 to the Regional Director of Transportation, 50 Wolf Road, Albany, New York 12205. If requested, a corridor public hearing will be scheduled dealing with the proposed alternative locations for the reconstruction project. A future public hearing, if requested, will be offered at a later date for consideration of details of design along the routing selected, following the corridor hearing and review of the facts and views presented at it.

The proposed project extends from Route 9 in the vicinity of Exit 28 of the Adirondack Northway (Interstate Route 87) at Severance and extends east-ly to Chilson.

Two possible alternative locations are being considered for the reconstruction. One would generally follow the existing alignment of Route 73, providing for improvements in curves and grades, and the other would be along a new location to the south of the present highway.

If requested, the corridor hearing would allow interested persons to express their views on the economic or social effects of the proposed project, its impact upon the environment or its consistency with local planning objectives. Information on the project
