

Aug 22 Eagle Lake 1940

The 33rd Annual Meeting of the Eagle Lake Property Owners Association was convened on Saturday, August 10th, 1940, at 2 p. m., D.S.T., at "Ednet" Lodge, Eagle Lake.

The following officers and committees were elected to serve for the ensuing year: President, Francis Allen Wickes; vice president, George F. Humphries; secretary-treasurer, Edmund O. Luthy; Advisory committee, Messrs. Geo. E. Hurd and Eliot Spalding and Miss Lillian Cowan; fisheries committee, Messrs. E. O. Luthy, Samuel Danes and F. Allen Wickes; special committee on restoration of the dam, Messrs. Eliot Spalding, Sheldon F. Wickes and Henry D. Rodgers.

No definite progress has been attained toward restoring the dam, though it is believed that it is the duty of the Conservation Department (as the dam-site is now State property) to replace and restore the dam in order to bring back to former condition the spawning beds along the outlet of the lake and thus aid in reviving pristine fishing conditions by the propagation of a better fish supply following the continued planting of bass and thereby protect the predatory species which inhabit Eagle Lake.

It is hoped that Assemblyman Sheldon F. Wickes can succeed in inducing the State Conservation Commission to restore the dam and thus maintain the fish supply, in accord with its function to protect, preserve and increase the habitat of this water for the benefit of the sportsmen living in the vicinity of Ticonderoga.

The secretary reported that beginning with 1940, until further action, the payment of annual dues by the members will be remitted.
