to Hunt:- You sent of 29th June just postmarked - I have already
written to Lodge to confer with the C. & C. on this matter as he is "on the ground".
I enclose you copy of my letter to him, which please return to me for my files.

In this letter you will note condition of matters & that I have now received
notice from the Commission of approval of some plans & public notices for the
reconstruction of the Dams, which are ass-filled with them early in last Sept.

As I had hoped that the Commission would possibly build the Dams
then and C. & C. I do not know their acceptance of my application
I attempt by holding off. We might save the expense of it to our

property owners if they (the C.) should build it themselves.

If you should cast the Dams jurisdiction you will understand
by my letter to Lodge, my intention further.

If there is positive proof that I believe provided the Dams
I see no reason why, if the C. has any jurisdiction over the Dams,
they should not be allowed to build the Dams in accordance

with the plans as demanded of us & this work is done
I would like to know whether the Commission will consent
to do this, I am hardly in a position to be property owners as individuals

have any cause in action.

I would therefore suggest that you as Chm. Fok Com. of our Assoc.
write the Commission in answer on these lines, & ascertain what they
will do in the matter. I would suggest that you keep in touch with

Lodge in the matter as well as as not to conflict in your work.

As soon as the matter comes to a questioning individual
damage done to the property. I will confer with you first & then first
duty to the first steps to be taken in my instructions for us to take

up the matter with the C. as an Organization, with the object of
personal arrangements to follow upon the matter, or otherwise decided
by the Commission.
