* Measurements Taken *
 * at Goose Neck Pond *
 * Refute News Story *
 * In direct contradiction to an *
 * erroneous article which ap- *
 * peared in a Glens Falls newspa- *
 * per several days ago, stating *
 * that the water supply at Goose *
 * Neck Pond is at a dangerously *
 * low ebb, village authorities yes- *
 * terday ordered that careful *
 * measurements be taken at the *
 * pond.

* The measurements, as dis- *
 * closed this morning, indicate *
 * that the water has dropped 22 *
 * inches since the supply was *
 * turned into the mains of Ticon- *
 * deroga on August 7th, despite *
 * the fact that there has been no *
 * rainfall of importance for near- *
 * ly two months. In the past *
 * eight days, the water level drop- *
 * ped 3 inches.

* It was discovered that at the *
 * location of the intake, there is *
 * now a depth from the surface *
 * of the water to the pipe, of 11 *
 * feet and 4 inches, although the *
 * Ticonderoga correspondent of *
 * the Glens Falls paper inferred *
 * that any depth at this point was *
 * almost negligible.

* The correspondent also im- *
 * plied that the water level had *
 * dropped approximately eight *
 * feet since the new supply was *
 * inaugurated. This statement is *
 * without foundation, as the con- *
 * tractors in charge were compell- *
 * ed to lower the level six feet *
 * BEFORE the source was open- *
 * ed, and the actual lowering of *
 * the water level since the open- *
 * ing measure, as stated above, *
 * exactly twenty-nine inches.
