

MINUTES OF THE 22nd ANNUAL MEETING OF THE
EAGLE LAKE PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION HELD
AT "ERNET" LODGE, EAGLE LAKE, ESSEX CO., N.Y. ON SATURDAY AUGUST 10, 1929

The twenty second annual meeting of the Eagle Lake Property Owners' Association held on Saturday Aug 10th 1929 at "Ernet" Lodge, Eagle Lake, Essex Co., N.Y. was called to order at 2:40 P.M. (Standard time) by Vice Pres. Mr. F. Humphries in the absence of Pres. Alfred Weld in person a notice of said meeting having been sent to the members by mail in accordance with ART VIII SEC 1. of the By-Laws of the Association.

Answering the roll call the following members were recorded as present: - Miss Cowan, Mrs. Humphries, Ruthy, Lodge, & Rogers, in person, Mrs. Charlotte Nord represented by Mr. G. E. Nord in person, and Miss Fitz Gerald & Rohrs represented by Fordy sent to Ed. Ruthy, being a total enrollment of 8 members which constituted a quorum enabling the meeting complete to proceed with the business for which it was called.

The Secretary then read the minutes of the last meeting ^{held on Aug 4, 1928} which were approved as read.

A letter from the N.Y. Development Adm. Rec. in Rec. Conference at Albany on July 18 on a proposed puffed grouse investigation was received & ordered filed.

A public notice from the Conservation Commission in the matter of the petition of Frank C. Sherman et al for a hearing on the danger of extermination to fish in the waters of Lake George (prohibition of traps) was received & filed.

The written annual report of the Seely-Jones was then presented & on motion made & carried it was accepted as read & ordered filed.

The Annual Report of the Commissioner of Fisheries was read & accepted & ordered filed and the Secretary instructed to submit matters therein to the Conservation Commission.

The following resolution was adopted & the Secy instructed to send copies to Mrs. Emil Runge & to Mr. Frank B. Wickes.

Be it resolved that the members of this association at the annual meeting held Aug 10 1929, voice their sentiments & expressions in extending their deepest sympathy and sincere condolence for the recent loss by death to the families of Mrs. Emil Runge and Mr. Frank B. Wickes.
