My dear Mr. Flint:

Yours of the 16th inst. at hand. Sincerely
hope Ferris & Newton will come to an amicable agreement about
the dam. If the dam is raised two feet, I would recommend in-
creasing the width at the bottom by 12". Personally, I think
the two foot raise might meet with serious objections from the
boat house owners, as it would probably flood the boat house
floors. I am and have always been very much in favor of rais-
ing the dam twelve inches (in which case increase bottom width
6") as from inspections I am sure the boat houses will not be
seriously affected and the increased spawning area for the fish
will help the fishing very much. The dam should be built this
summer, in fact the sooner the better, that is, in case of an
amicable settlement.
